

Medications

Permission for medication to be administered at school must be given by parents in writing.

The school nurse will liaise with parents regarding the writing of a care plan PRIOR to a child starting school. This will list medication, times and procedures specific to your child. Once you have signed this it will be shared with class staff and adhered to in school.

All medication must be labelled with your child's name and have a clear expiration date. It is the parent's responsibility to inform the school in writing if there are any changes to their child's medication.

If you need to make changes to your child's medication you can download and print a Medication Administration Form. However, it MUST be signed and sent to school before we can adhere to the instructions.
